The Columbia County Department of Health has received the seasonal Flu vaccine for the 2025 - 2026 season and have scheduled 3 community clinics to offer these vaccines. At this time, the Columbia County Department of Health is awaiting guidance on COVID vaccines. Information will be released in future communications.

The following scheduled clinics are the only community clinics available for anyone 6 months of age and older who would like to receive a flu vaccine. **Pre-registration is required.**

You can register for a clinic by going to the Columbia County Department of Health website at www.columbiacountynyhealth.com and clicking on the link or QR code and choosing only one of these offered clinics.

Most insurances are accepted, if you are uninsured or underinsured you may be eligible for a lower fee or no fee for the flu vaccine. All others are expected to pay a fee of \$58.00 for regular flu and \$107.00 for the high dose senior flu vaccine. Cash, card or check accepted.
