Breaking Nicotine's Grip: A Two-Part Series for Providers

Wednesday, July 15 (12pm-1pm) Part 2: Pharmacotherapy for Youth Tobacco & Nicotine Cessation focuses on evidence-based pharmacotherapy for adolescent nicotine cessation, safety considerations, treatment options, and case-based strategies for shared decision-making and follow-up.
